**DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE**

**Description of proposal:** Turnover Timber Sale, Agreement No. 30-107976 and Forest Practices Application No. 2943359. This is a variable retention harvest with 155 acres in 4 units and 3 acres of right of way harvest in 1 unit, for a total of 158 acres in 5 units, removing approximately 6,133 MBF of timber, with 3,819 feet of road construction, 2,900 feet of road reconstruction, 29,264 feet of pre-haul maintenance, and 1,897 feet of road abandonment.

**Proponent:** Department of Natural Resources

**Location of proposal, including street address, if any:** Sections 1, 2, 11 and 12 all in Township 6 North, Range 4 East, W.M., approximately 8.1 miles by road, southeast of Cougar, off the S-6000 and S-6050 road systems in Clark County, Washington.

**Lead agency:** Department of Natural Resources


